- It emphasizes the _____ honor which God places upon the union of husband and wife
- **Two ways to view this book:**
 - 1) The bridegroom is Solomon, a type of Christ who woes and loves his bride. The Bride is a Shulamite woman who pictures the church.
 - 2) Solomon pictures the world, the Shulamite pictures the church, her shepherd/fiancé pictures Jesus
- Spurgeon called this book “the Holy of Holies of the Bible”
